Subject: Proposed Airport Traffic Control Tower Replacement Project

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is announcing that the Draft Supplemental Environmental Assessment (SEA) for the proposed Airport Traffic Control Tower (ATCT) Replacement Project at the Sacramento International Airport (SMF), Sacramento, Sacramento County, California, is available for public comment.

The FAA will accept comments on the proposed project until close of business Monday, May 4, 2026. Please submit comments to Patrick Walsh at patrick.walsh@faa.gov. Comments received shall be addressed within the final SEA.

The following project is addressed by the draft SEA:

- Construction of a new ATCT, administrative base building, and parking lot to the north side of the SMF Airport (Latitude, Longitude; 38.702779, -121.591465).
- Installation and connection of new utility conduits for water, sewer, and electrical power.
- A fence would be installed around the perimeter of the new ATCT. Controlled access would be provided at secure gates intersecting the new interior access roads. Security lighting would also be installed.
- Installation of modern air traffic control equipment such as radar, communication, backup power, and surveillance systems.
- Demolition of the existing ATCT, administrative base building, parking lot, and perimeter fencing directly south of Concourse B (5620 Alan Boyd Drive, Sacramento, CA 95837).
- Lease acquisition of new ATCT and lease termination of existing ATCT from the Sacramento County Department of Airports.

The FAA's Federal actions for this project include:

- Unconditional approval of portions of the Airport Layout Plan (ALP) that depict those components of the Proposed Project subject to FAA review and approval pursuant to 49 USC § 47107(a)(16)(B),(x);
