

## 10yr FBI Criminal History Check List of Disqualifying Criminal Offenses

Per 49 CFR 1542.209, anyone convicted or found not guilty by reason of insanity of any of the below criminal offenses within the last 10 years is disqualified from having an Airport Badge.

- **Felony involving any of the following-**
  - Involving a threat
  - Arson
  - Willful destruction of property
  - Importation of, manufacture of a controlled substance
  - Burglary
  - Theft
  - Dishonesty, fraud, or misrepresentation
  - Possession, or distribution of stolen property
  - Aggravated assault
  - Bribery
  - Illegal possession of a controlled substance punishable of a maximum term of imprisonment of more than one year
- **Felony or Misdemeanor**
  - Armed or felony unarmed robbery
  - Distribution of , or intent to distribute, a controlled substance
  - Kidnapping or hostage taking
  - Murder
  - Assault with intent to murder
  - Rape or aggravated sexual assault
  - Extortion
  - Unlawful possession, use, sale distribution or manufacturing of an explosive or weapon
  - Forgery of certificates, false marking of aircraft and other aircraft registration violation, 49 U.S.C. 46306
  - Interference with air navigation; 49 U.S.C. 46308
  - Improper transportation of a hazardous material; 49 U.S.C. 46312
  - Aircraft Piracy; 49 U.S.C. 46502
  - Interference with flight crewmembers or flight attendants; 49 U.S.C. 46504
  - Commission of certain crimes aboard aircraft in flight; 49 U.S.C. 46t506
  - Carrying a weapon or explosive aboard aircraft; 49 U.S.C. 46505
  - Conveying false information and threats; 49 U.S.C. 46507
  - Aircraft piracy outside the special aircraft jurisdiction of the United States; 49 U.S.C. 46502(b)
  - Lighting violations involving transporting controlled substances; 49 U.S.C. 46315
  - Unlawful entry into an aircraft of airport area that serves air carriers or foreign air carriers contrary to established requirements; 49 U.S.C. 46314
  - Destruction of an aircraft or aircraft facility; 49 U.S.C. 32
  - Espionage
  - Sedition
  - Treason
  - Violence at International airports;18 U.S.C. 37
  - Conspiracy or attempt to commit any acts listed above.
