

AIRPORT BOULEVARD DETOUR



A \$1.1 million project on northbound Interstate 5 to lengthen the auxiliary lane and exit ramp to the Sacramento International Airport will begin on **Tuesday, April 19** and last approximately 30 days, weather permitting. To accommodate construction, crews plan to close the northbound I-5 exit to the airport from **9 p.m. to 4 a.m.** on **April 19, 20 and 21**, requiring motorists to follow a six-mile detour during the overnight work. During this time lane restrictions will be from **7 p.m. - 5 a.m.** Caltrans urges motorists trying to make their flights to add 30-35 minutes additional travel time. Motorists also can expect lane restrictions on NB I-5 approaching the airport. The project will lengthen the exit ramp and auxiliary lane about 1,800 feet to add capacity and help lessen traffic backing up onto the freeway.
